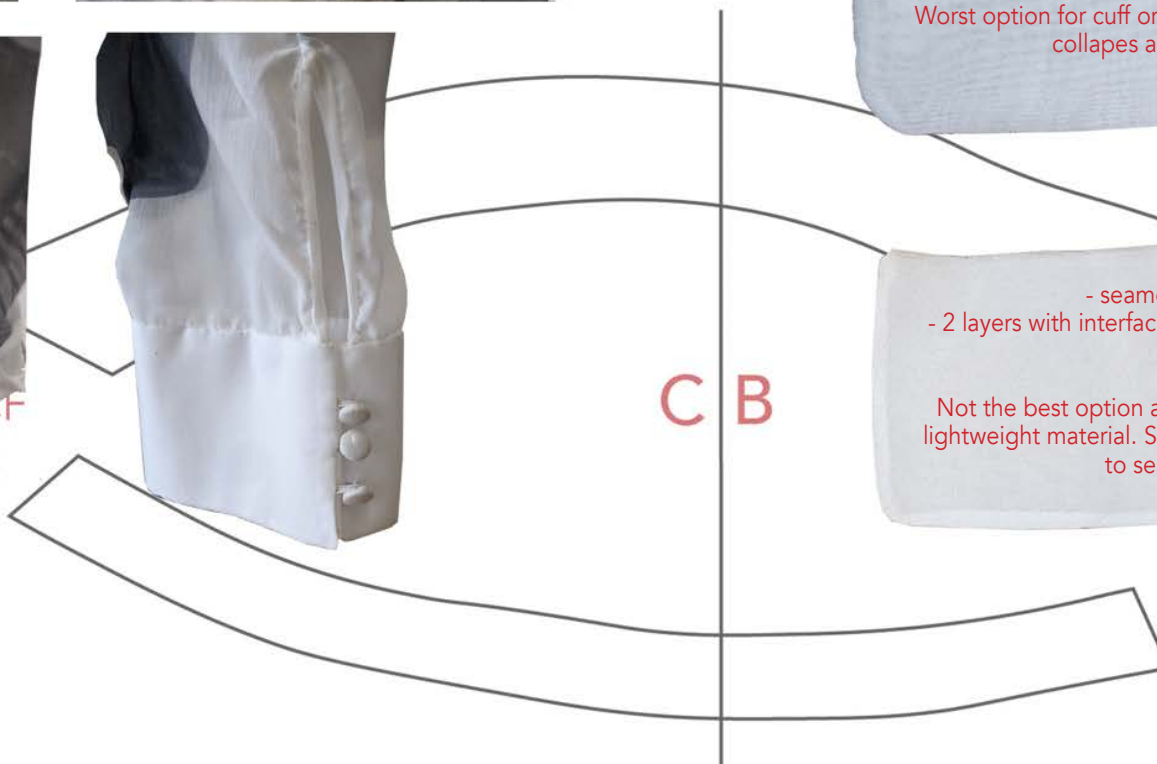




Details from the blouse: Small popper to close collar and fabric covered buttons with elastic loops. I sewed a double pleat into the back neck as it stretched while sewing.



I used bias binding to hong kong bind the hems, seams and placket inside blouse. I basted the binding in with the seams then sewed them together and hand sewed the other side



- seamed all around edges
- 3 layers. 2 outer pieces and one middle piece with interfacing
Best structure for lightweight fabric that needs structure because of the interfacing and extra seam

- Folded in half
- 2 seams on sides
- no interfacing
Worst option for cuff or collar as it has no structure, therefore collapses as a cuff and collar option

- seamed all the way around
- 2 layers with interfacing on one side of fabric and not the other
Not the best option as the interfacing shows through the lightweight material. Still good as it holds shape a little due to seams and interfacing
