



- Houndstooth wool
- Soft crepe lining
- Coutil



I sewed the gathers for this dress by hand at 1cm apart. Sewing and pulling each line of thread was the most tedious part of the making process as the side panels alone take up 1.5m of fabric

The final toile for this design was a great fit/ silhouette and resolved all the issues of this design apart from internal finishings such as linings. The hem on this toile is a turn up hem and worked well with the weight and starchiness of the calico

Internal corset lined with canvas at the neckline to keep the structure of the dress and hold the weight of the gathers. Extra strong boning was also used to hold up the weight of this garment
